Prior to joining SIT in September 2019, he was the Dean of Engineering at the National University of Singapore (NUS). From 1995 to 2000, he was seconded from NUS to the Centre for Wireless Communications (now the Institute for Infocomm Research), a national telecommunications R&D centre funded by the National Science and Technology Board (now Singapore Agency for Science, Technology and Research) as its Deputy Director. From 2001 to 2003,

he was on leave of absence from NUS to work at Siemens AG where he was the Founding Head of the Mobile Core R&D Department in Singapore funded by Siemens' ICM Group. From 2006 to 2008, he was seconded from NUS to the National Research Foundation in the Prime Minister's Office as a Director. He chaired the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on Robotics and Smart Devices in 2011 and spoke on the role of robotics and smart devices in shaping new models of development at the World Economic Forum in Davos in January 2012. He is a recipient of an IEEE 3rd Millennium Medal, a Fellow of the Singapore Academy of Engineering, and a Fellow of the Institution of Engineers, Singapore. His research interests are in communication networks.
